National Taiwan Normal University Department of Chemistry Direct Admissions into PhD Programs Guidelines

Article 1 These regulations are based on the guidelines set forth by National Taiwan Normal University for students aiming to pursue a doctoral degree directly without completing a master's degree.

Article 2. Eligibility:

Applicants must be current students of our school and possess all the following qualifications:

- (1) Hold a bachelor's degree or be in the process of completing a master's degree.
- (2) Demonstrate outstanding academic performance, with bachelor's degree candidates ranking within the top 20% of their graduating class.

Article 3. Application Quota:

The number of positions available for this program is limited to 40% of the doctoral program's total enrollment quota as approved by the Ministry of Education for the academic year.

- Article 4. Application Timeline and Procedure:
 - (1) Deadline: Applications must be submitted within 10 working days before the deadline for doctoral program admissions and examinations.
 - (2) Required Documents include:
 - (I) One application form.
 - (II) Official transcripts from undergraduate and higher education levels. For bachelor's degree students, proof of ranking within the top 20% is required.
 - (III) Research reports or published papers.
 - (IV) Two recommendation letters from associate professors or higher.
 - (V) Any additional relevant materials that might enhance the application.
 - (3) Applications for direct entry to the doctoral program must be completed by the end of April and November each year.
- Article 5 These regulations will be implemented after being approved by the department's executive meeting, and the same will apply when revised.
